Dear Parents and Guardians,

The La Honda-Pescadero Unified School District is working in close collaboration with the San Mateo County Office of Education and the San Mateo County Health Department to monitor and control the spread of the Coronavirus, known as COVID-19, in the Bay Area.

**Today, I will receive notification from the San Mateo County Department of Health that all schools in San Mateo County shall be ordered to dismiss students for the next three weeks, March 16<sup>th</sup>- April 3<sup>rd</sup>.** I recognize the tremendous burden this places on our families. Our students are being dismissed to help stop the spread of the virus in the wider community NOT because there is a heightened risk in our schools. There are no active cases or contacts in our schools at this time.

What does this mean?

- We will transition to “at home learning” and provide instructional materials (packets) to all students in our district for the duration of the student dismissal.
- We will keep our kitchen open and continue to provide meal service to students.
- We will maintain staff on our campuses to support students and families utilizing *social distancing* practices of maintaining 6 feet of distance between people.
- We will work in coordination with our community partners to support students and families during this difficult time.

I will send a follow up notice later in the day with more details but want to give you as much time as possible to plan for your child’s wellbeing during the dismissal.
